



## **The 'Quiz'**

### **Purpose?**

To reinforce the main teaching point of the day whilst having fun!

### **What's Involved?**

The whole team should be involved in planning the daily Quiz, as well as sourcing any equipment / props that may be necessary for it. Most of your effort should go into thinking about how best to communicate the message rather than building props, etc.

### **Who Does What?**

Everyone on the team should be involved in some way, both in preparation and on the day - the team can decide amongst themselves who does what. It's best to nominate one person as the team captain to ensure somebody takes responsibility for the team getting things done!

### **What Should It Be Like?**

Extremely visual, stimulating, dynamic and fun!

The team can use music, lights, drama, PowerPoint or anything else they can think of. It is sometimes better to run the same quiz game every day, to allow the children to get used to how it works, rather than trying to introduce different quizzes each day.

As a starting point, try to think of it as the Ultimate TV Game Show!

### **How Should The Scoring Work?**

The quiz game itself can have any points structure you like, as long as it is fair.

### **How Long Should It Take?**

A maximum of fifteen minutes each day.
